What is the purpose of SEAC?

The Essex County Public Schools Special Education Advisory Committee works with the school board, administrators, parents, and teachers who are responsible for students receiving special education services.

Who serves on the committee?

SEAC members are comprised of parents and guardians of students with disabilities, teacher representatives and service agency representatives. The Special Education Director serves as a consultant to SEAC.

Who may attend the SEAC meeting?

All meetings are open to the public and anyone interested in special education is welcome to attend the meetings. There is a designated time for public comment during the meeting. This is an opportunity to share successful educational experiences and express general concerns regarding issues for students with disabilities.
