

STUDENT SUSPENSION/EXPULSION

Grounds for Suspension

The following violations of the Code of Student Conduct and School Board policy are grounds for suspension:

- Assault
- Cheating
- Class disturbance
- Communication Devices
- Defacement of School Property
- Defiance of Authority of School Personnel
- Drug and Alcohol Violation as Prescribed by Policy
- Excessive Display of Affection
- Excessive Tardies to Class
- Extortion
- Fighting
- Harassment Toward Another Student
- In Unauthorized Area or Hall Without a Pass
- Inappropriate Behavior
- Inappropriate Touching
- Inciting Students to Create Disturbance
- Leaving Class Without Permission
- Leaving School Grounds Without Permission
- Making Disrespectful or Insulting Remarks
- Misuse of School Computer
- Obscene Gesture
- Possession of Alcohol
- Possession of Drug Paraphernalia
- Sexual Harassment
- Skipping Class
- Smoking or Possession of Tobacco Products
- Stealing
- Tampering with Fire Alarm
- Throwing of Objects
- Use of Alcohol
- Use of Drugs
- Use of Profanity
- Verbal Threat to Teacher/Staff
- Any Additional Behaviors as Defined in the School Code of Conduct That Warrant a Suspension

Grounds for Expulsion

The following violations of the Code of Student Conduct and School Board policy are grounds for expulsion:

- Arson: Actual; Arson: Attempted
- Lighted Firecrackers, Cherry Bombs, Stink Bombs (That Contribute to a Damaging Fire); Bringing Fireworks, Firecrackers or Stink Bombs to School or School Event
- Possession of Explosive Device; Use of a Bomb or Explosive Device
- Possessing or Bringing to School or a School-Sponsored Event any Substance Used as a Weapon (Mace, Tear Gas, or Pepper Spray)
- Possession of Firearm; Possession of a Shotgun or Rifle; Possession of Weapon That Expels a Projectile; Possession of Other Firearms
- Possession of a Knife (Blade 3 inches or longer)
- Use of a Bomb or Explosive Device
- Possession of Other Weapons
- Ammunition
- Pneumatic Weapon; Toy/Look-alike; Razor Blade; Stun Gun; Taser
- Inciting a Riot
- Setting Off False Fire Alarm
- Battery/Assault (Staff with Weapon); Battery/Assault (Staff no Weapon); Battery/Assault (Student with Weapon); Battery/Assault (Student no Weapon); Malicious Wounding (No Weapon)
- Bomb Threat; Chemical/Biological Threat; Terrorist Threat
- Actual Robbery and Attempted Robbery
- Alcohol Sales/Distribution
- Possession with Intent to Sell or Distribute Schedule I & II Drug Sale/Distribution; Synthetic Marijuana Distribution; Over-the-Counter/Prescription Medication/Sale/Distribution; Marijuana Sale/Distribution; Other Drug Sale/Distribution (includes cannabimimetic agents); Substances Represented as Drugs (Look-Alikes); Anabolic Steroid Sale/Distribution; Drug violations of prescription drugs, theft, or attempted theft of prescription drugs
